Here we go toward summer again, and we at Angel Cat Pet Adoptions would like to thank you all for your support this past year! It's been a busy and challenging year for all of us here in our little rescue group, as we know it has been for you all too.

Some of you may remember the story in the OC Register this past November about three of the kittens who came to us this past summer. **Megan and Eli** came to us two days old in August. **Megan** was born with a virus in her right eye and when her eyes opened, it was clear that the eye couldn't stay. The overwhelming support that came in from all of you enabled her to have the bad eye removed in February. She needed to be closer to her full size to do well in the surgery and now she is the happiest, most playful kitten with her brother. A wonderful person has even donated the adoption fee for both **Megan and Eli** to go together to the right family. They are so sweet and friendly, we know they would be a great addition to an Angel family. The other kitten featured in the story, **Kohl**, who was thrown from a moving car is healthy and doing well in his foster home. He is so very fearful of humans still, and even if we don't ever find someone who is willing to work through his emotional issues with him, he will always have a home with his loving foster mom. We hope that someday he will realize that we love him and no one will ever hurt him again so he can relax and be happy.

Then, in February, we were able to assist some 8 cats with medical testing and services that came from a hoarding situation in North Orange County. We ultimately kept two of the kittens in our rescue, had them spayed and neutered and they are available for adoption now. Their names are **Buddy** and **Meadow**, they are about 7 months old and you can see them on our website at www.angelcatpetadoptions.org. They are so adorable! **Meadow** is a beautiful orange tabby girl with white markings and green eyes who loves to be held and **Buddy** is a handsome spotted grey tabby lap cat of a boy with white markings who loves to play and purr.


