Spring is here! We had such a warm February here in Orange County that kittens are already being born. That makes for a busy rescue season for sure! We are definitely gearing up! Kittens have a pretty small adoption window for those looking to add a new bundle of kitten energy to their home. Once they reach about a year old and are teenagers, their chances diminish and even though they are still young, they are often overlooked for the cute babies. Of course, we think cats and kittens of any age are awesome. As I've grown older, I appreciate a nice laid back adult cat to cuddle!

You may wonder why you see some of the same cats season after season on our news letter. These are the cats that have literally grown up in foster homes and still looking for furrever homes. They all started out as cute baby kittens and for whatever reason, missed their adoption window. We keep our Angel Cats until they find their furrever home no matter how long that may be, so these are the cats we feature. Some of them have been with us 5 years! We did have several of our kids find new homes since the last newsletter, Amber (6 yrs old, foster for 5) and Penny (3 yrs old, foster for 2), Hunter (Penny's brother, 3yrs old also foster for 2), and it gives us such joy to see them blossom in a furrever home finally. Our darling boys Sylvester and Mochi were also adopted into wonderful families. They were the last to go from last spring's kitten crop! Sometimes the kittens we take in never even make it onto the newsletter, they are adopted within a few weeks or months of arriving.

I want to thank all of you who support us and the work we do with your generous donations. We are a 501c3 non-profit rescue and all donations are tax deductible. We are also an all volunteer rescue group, every cent goes to food, litter and veterinarian care for the cats in our foster homes. We have had a couple of kitty medical issues this winter that have left us operating on a shoe string right now and we would be so grateful for donations of any amount. We have been blessed these 8 years since Angel Cat was "born" to somehow always have just enough to do what we need but it takes all of you awesome cat lovers for that to happen. So, please help if you can, it means so much to us and the cats.

Our two colonies of TNR'd feral cats are growing a bit, both colonies have had a new member or two join since the fall. Of course, we get them checked by our Vet, vaccinated and spayed/neutered. We have to trap them in humane traps and sometimes they are so smart they can avoid springing it and still get the food. I think we trap more opossum than cats! But we persevere until we get who we want! Thankfully, no kittens are in our colonies currently and that is a testament to TNR and that it really does work!
